Dear Mr. Novosel,

I am writing to you on behalf of my clients, professional basketball [REDACTED] and professional basketball [REDACTED], who have both at certain points in their careers worked for the Basketball Club Zadar (hereinafter as "KK Zadar").

KK Zadar is still indebted to my clients for the payment of their salaries, for which they successfully sued the Club in the Basketball Arbitration Tribunal (hereinafter as "BAT"). Due to the continuing breach of the obligation (for more than two years) to honour the BAT Award, KK Zadar not only became banned by the International Basketball Federation (hereinafter as "FIBA") from registering new players but also from participating in international competitions, which the ABA League most certainly is.

Regardless of the above-imposed sanctions, KK Zadar will be allowed to participate in this year's season in the ABA League (Adriatic League).

I am hereby asking you to respect the BAT Awards and thus the sanctions imposed by FIBA, regardless of the ongoing disputes between FIBA Europe and Euroleague Commercial Assets Ltd. (hereinafter as "ECA") in relation to the organisation of
